SURVEY ON EFFECT TO EC OPERATIONS DURING THE SUBJECT

ENHANCED/GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (ECQ)

**DUE TO COVID-19 SITUATION** 

This Office appreciates the immediate and current actions taken by the Electric Cooperatives to address the COVID-19 situation in order to ensure the continuous delivery of electricity in the respective franchise areas covered amidst the pandemic. The EC Risk Management and Sustainability Plan (EcRM-SP), otherwise referred to as Business Continuity Plan (BCP), submitted by the Electric Cooperatives (ECs) showed the risk treatment and mitigating measures formulated in response to the national health crisis, and we are hopeful that the courses of action taken thus far, and those that shall be undertaken will serve to ensure the continuity and sustainability of EC operations.

In response to numerous query and concerns raised by or from energy stakeholders, the National Electrification Administration is conducting this formal survey/gathering of data on the EC Monthly Comparative Statistical Data for the months of January to May 2020 intended to obtain additional data and important information relative to the effect of the Enhanced or General Community Quarantine effected by the national and local government to the overall operations and performance of the Distribution Utilities. particularly to the ECs in the country. Further, this will serve as a source of updated information for this Office to act on and/or support the lobby/recommendation for action from state legislation and regulatory agencies to address the concerns and attend to the interests of energy stakeholders, especially to the ECs and its member consumer-owners (MCOs).

Accordingly, the ECs are enjoined to provide their respective data and information reflected in the EC Monthly Comparative Statistical Data Sheet to cover the data/information prevailing for the period January to April 2020, hereto attached (Excel file). The accomplished survey form shall be submitted to NEA via email at nea\_mag@yahoo.com on or before 11 May 2020.
