1. Nature of the Practice Circle

The Ask Erin Practice Circle is a facilitated, peer-based discussion and accountability group focused on professional learning, reflection, and practical integration. It is not legal representation, mediation services, therapy, or formal instruction. The organizer and facilitator is Erin Birt.

2. Professional Education

The Practice Circle does not provide CLE or CEU credit. Any third-party educational materials discussed are offered by their original providers. Participants are responsible for determining whether any content qualifies for credit under their own licensing requirements.

3. Confidentiality & Group Expectations

Participants agree to respect the confidentiality of group discussions and to engage in a professional, respectful manner. While Erin Birt facilitates the group, she is not responsible for the conduct or statements of individual participants.

4. Participation & Commitment

Participation operates on a rolling 90-day commitment with monthly, in-person meetings. Continued participation reflects an agreement to attend regularly and contribute thoughtfully to the group.

5. Fees & Recommitment

Fees are billed quarterly. Participation continues unless notice of non-renewal is provided at least 14 days before the next billing cycle. The firm will process payment(s) using the payment method provided by participant at time of enrollment. The firm uses secure online payments via 8am/LawPay.
