ORDER

This case is before the Court on Magistrate Judge Catherine M. Salinas’ Non-Final Report and Recommendation (“R&R”). [Doc. 71]. The Court “may accept, reject, or modify, in whole or in part, the findings or recommendations made by the magistrate judge.” 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1); FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b)(3). No objections to the Magistrate Judge’s R&R have been filed, and therefore, the Court has reviewed the R&R for clear error. See Thomas v. Arn, 474 U.S. 140, 154 (1985); Macort v. Prem, Inc., 208 F. App’x 781, 784 (11th Cir. 2006); Tauber v. Barnhart, 438 F. Supp. 2d 1366, 1373 (N.D. Ga. 2006). The Court finds no error.

Accordingly, the Court **ADOPTS** the R&R [Doc. 71] as the opinion of this Court. For the reasons stated in the R&R, the Court **DENIES** Defendant Adaptive

Learning Center for Infants and Children, Inc.'s Motion for Summary Judgment. [Doc. 44]. Further, pursuant to Local Rule 16.4, the Court **DIRECTS** the Parties to confer and submit a proposed consolidated pretrial order within thirty (30) days from the date of entry of this order. See LR 16.4(A), NDGa.
