

BTU Board Getting Two New Members

Current and new leadership are coming to the BTU Board.

Tuesday night the Bryan City Council voted unanimously to reappoint BTU Board Members Ralph Davilla and Manuel Glockzin Junior to three years terms.

The council also appointed two new members Ronnie Craig and Chris Peterson to the board.

Craig brings [finance](#) experience and Peterson legal experience.

The two replace former board members Bill Atkinson and Gene Kornegay who resigned last month.

"We had both BTU and City of Bryan, the city [manager](#) in executive session talking about the BTU budget and going over some of the competitive matters today if there's some information that might be lacking, BTU has provided some of that here in the last couple of days. So the two staffs have been working very well together," said Bryan Mayor Jason Bienski.

The city will adopt next year's [budget](#) September first.
