### **Life Expectancy for Incarcerated Individuals**

**If life expectancy for federal inmates is 64 years, John Knock has served a life sentence.**

The actual extent of the diminished life expectancy resulting from imprisonment was addressed by the United States Sentencing Commission. This is based on average life expectancy and median age of individual at time of sentencing.

The life expectancy for a person in general prison population is 64 years of age.
