**ORDER ON PLAINTIFF’S *EX PARTE* MOTION TO
EXTEND THE TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER**

THIS CAUSE has come before the Court on Plaintiff’s Motion to Extend the TRO (the “Motion”). The Court, having considered the Motion, finds as follows:

Plaintiff has demonstrated good cause to grant the Motion, and no party will be prejudiced by an extension of the TRO. ORDER AND ADJUDGED: Plaintiff’s Motion is hereby **GRANTED**.

The Court finds that Plaintiff has demonstrated good cause for an extension of the TRO through and including to January 21, 2026. The previously entered TRO [D.E. 11] is hereby extended until January 21, 2026.

Any response or opposition to Plaintiff's request for a preliminary injunction must be served on Plaintiff's counsel by January 15, 2026, and filed with the court, along with Proof of Service. Plaintiff shall file any reply memorandum prior to January 15, 2026.

The hearing before this Court in the United States Courthouse located at 75 Ted Turner Drive SW, Atlanta, Georgia 30303, Courtroom 1905, on January 21, 2026 at 11:30 A.M., remains, at which time Defendants and/or any other affected persons may challenge the appropriateness of the TRO and move to dissolve the same, and at which time the Court will hear argument on Plaintiff's requested preliminary injunction. Defendants shall appear and show cause why said preliminary injunction should not issue.
