MINUTE entry before the Honorable April M. Perry: Plaintiff's motion for default judgment [43] is taken under advisement. Plaintiff's motion for default judgment will be heard on 6/9/2026 at 10:00 a.m. in person in Courtroom 1725. Based on its review of Plaintiff's motion for default judgement, the Court requests supplemental briefing from Plaintiff prior to the hearing. First, the Court would appreciate it if Plaintiff could provide any evidence of a completed purchase in Illinois or any other evidence that would establish personal jurisdiction over this Defendant. See *Liu v. Monthly*, No. 25–2074, 2026 WL 880018, at \*2 (7th Cir. Mar. 31, 2026). Second, clarification is needed on Plaintiff's contradictory assertions that Defendant has either \$17,305.40 in its Amazon account or \$6,356.16. Compare Doc. 44 at 2 with 9. By 6/2/2026, Plaintiff is to file any supplemental evidence or briefing. Plaintiff must serve a copy of this minute order upon Defendant within two business days of its entry on the docket and promptly file proof of that service.
