PLAINTIFF’S MOTION FOR ENTRY OF CLERK’S DEFAULT

Plaintiff Shenzhen Dejiayun Network Technology Co., Ltd. (“Plaintiff” or “Dejiayun”), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby requests that the Clerk enter default in this matter pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 55(a) against the Defendants identified in the Schedule A to the Complaint (the “Defaulting Defendants”) as Nos. 1-112 on the grounds that the Defaulting Defendants have failed to appear or otherwise respond to the Complaint within the time prescribed by the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

1. On April 21, 2026, the Defaulting Defendants were served with the Summons, Schedule A, and a copy of the Complaint by email communication as authorized by this Court’s Order on Alternate Service [Doc. 22]. [Doc. 29-31].

2. The time allowed for the Defaulting Defendants to respond to the Complaint has expired. Neither Plaintiff nor the Court has granted the Defaulting Defendants an extension of time to respond to the Complaint. The Defaulting Defendants have failed to answer or otherwise respond to the Complaint or serve a copy of any Answer or other response upon Plaintiff’s attorney of record.

3. Plaintiff is informed and believes that the Defaulting Defendants are not considered infants or incompetent persons. Plaintiff is informed and believes that the Service Members Civil Relief Act does not apply.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Dejiayun requests that the Clerk enter default, as authorized by Fed. R. Civ. P. 55(a) against the Defaulting Defendants.
