**FINDINGS AND ORDER**

As the prosecution of PAUL in the above matter has ended in his favor namely, a finding of **NOT GUILTY** of OUI and the Defendant has immediately moved for restoration of his license, I find that the statutory presumption in favor of the restoration of his license stands as the Commonwealth has not shown by a fair preponderance of the evidence that the safety of the public would be endangered.

*Commonwealth objected to restoration "for the record" but did not present argument.*

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

The Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles is to restore his privilege to operate motor vehicles within Massachusetts.
