## PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

  - **4.** SCR 60.06(4), both on its face and as applied to Judge Siefert, is unconstitutional as a

matter of law. Specifically, it does not survive strict scrutiny analysis, and is unconstitutionally overbroad.

**WHEREFORE**, Plaintiffs respectfully request this Court grant *Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment*.
